

Church Guidelines

Family Promise of Butler County has host congregations who are committed to supporting families during this time of transition. Your family will arrive at the church by 5:30 p.m. every night. You will be shown a private space for your family to stay throughout the week. The volunteers at the church will provide a meal, evening activities, overnight accommodations, breakfast and lunch items.

In order to ensure a pleasant stay, we ask the following things:

- ❖ No Smoking in the building. There is a smoking area outside.
- ❖ No food in your room. No drinks except for water, necessary baby bottles and things with a screw top lid. However, the kitchen availability for the adults is determined by each church.
- ❖ Please bag your garbage as determined at each church.
- ❖ Children must be supervised by an adult family member at all times. Volunteers will not be watching the kids.

Things you might like to know:

- ❖ Your room or the church will be secure during the day so you may leave items behind if you want.
- ❖ If you have special needs (special diet, sippy cups, etc.) the volunteers will try to help in any way they can.
- ❖ There may be internet access for homework or job search if you ask.
- ❖ Children need to be in their room settling down between 8:30-9. The morning comes very early!
- ❖ The outside doors are locked at each church in the evening. Last smoke break should be prior to the doors being locked.
