




To help alleviate the needs of children and their families who are experiencing homelessness in **Butler County by providing** shelter, meals, diversion, and comprehensive support services.

IMPACT REPORT 2021



- 33 families were served in our shelter program, including 47 adults and 73 children
- 🙏 88% of families graduated from the program and left shelter for permanent affordable housing
- 0% of the 33 families have entered the homeless system again
- ★ 108 families (344) people) were served through our Diversion and Prevention program, allowing them to stay in their current housing



Family Promise could not exist without our partner congregations. During "normal" years, every evening, our van takes the families to a host congregation where they are warmly greeted by volunteers and each family is shown to a private sleeping area complete with the comforts of home. Guests and volunteers sit down to share a home-cooked meal and fellowship. Volunteers help with homework, play games with and read to the children. Two volunteers serve as overnight hosts and, each morning, prepare and serve breakfast. Guests make bag lunches for their families for the day. . Each congregation hosts families for one week at a time, 2-4 times per year.

Of course 2021 was not such a year. Due to Covid restraints, were housed in hotel rooms. Even so, many volunteers from congregations stepped up and provided meals and other for our families. As we move into 2022 we are hopeful to "rotational model" described above.
