

Volunteers

Family Promise could not exist without our partner congregations. Every evening, our van takes the families to a host congregation where they are warmly greeted by volunteers, they are shown to a sleeping area complete with the comforts of home and each family stays in a room together. Guests and volunteers sit down to share a home-cooked meal, conversation, friendship, and fellowship. Volunteers help with homework, provide tutoring, and play games with and read to the children. Two volunteers serve as overnight hosts and, each morning, prepare and serve breakfast. Guests make bag lunches for their families. Each congregation hosts families for one week at a time


